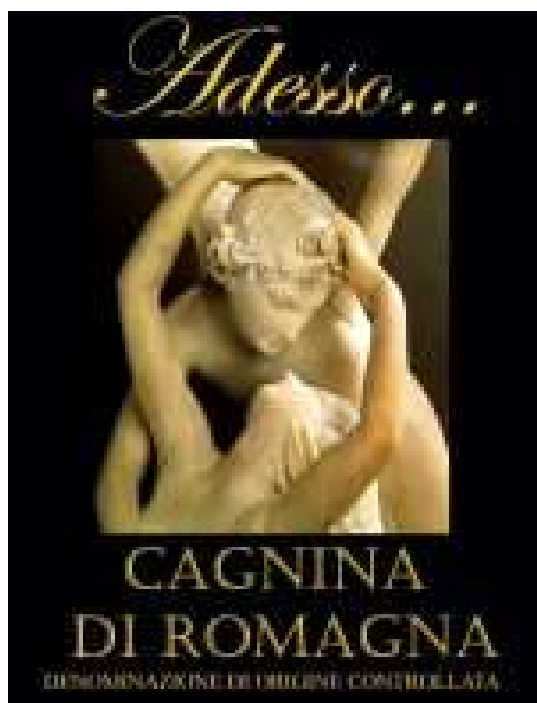


Adesso[®], Cagnina Di Romagna, DOC, 2024

Cagnina Dolce



Nobody knows from where the name Cagnina comes, but this wine has been made since the 13th century exclusively in the Emilia-Romagna Region, just south of Venice, in Italy. "Adesso[®]," which means "now" in Italian, is a wine that is easy to love.

Tasting Notes

Pleasantly sweet, Adesso[®] has berry aromas and flavors that are impossible to resist. Low in alcohol, Adesso[®] is a fun and easy to drink red wine for those who prefer their wines "off dry".
