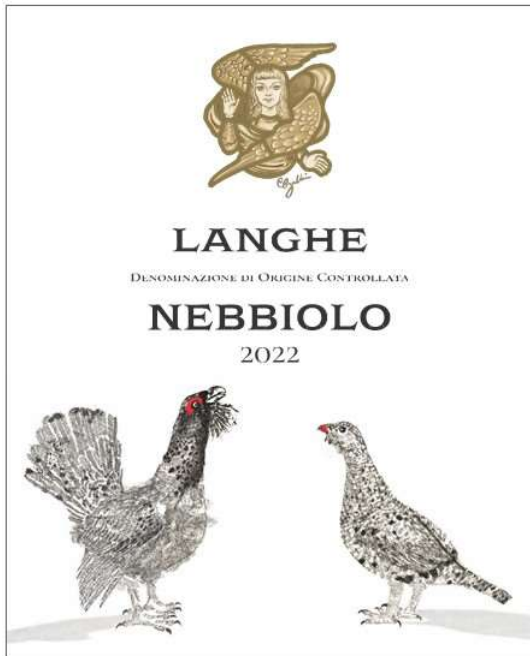


Langhe Nebbiolo, DOC, 2023

Cantine Sanmatteo



The winery is at an elevation of almost 1,000 feet, located in the small town of Cisterna D'Asti. Grapes have been growing in the vineyards of Cantine Sanmatteo since the first vine was planted in 1837.

The Producer states they do not use artificial fertilizers, herbicides or pesticides. While we cannot prove the veracity of this, we also have no reason to believe it is not true. The winery is certified as a sustainable winery by Equalitas.

Tasting Notes

A bouquet of violets and hints of rose on the nose, with rich dark fruit with a hint of leather on the palate. This garnet red dry wine is well structured with nice acidity and tannins to finish.
