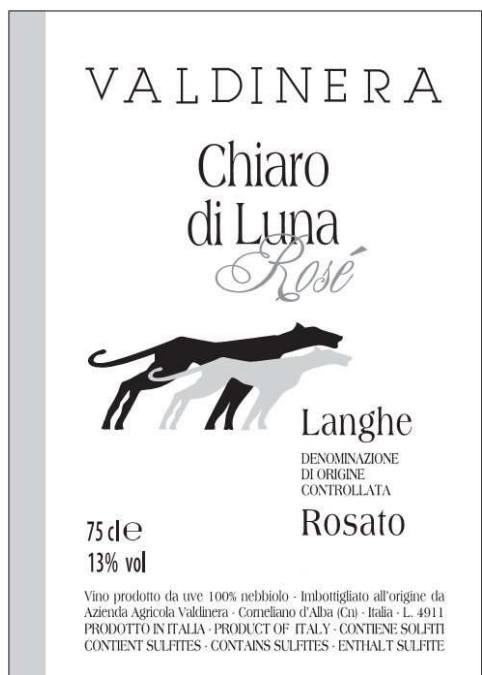


Chiaro Di Luna, Langhe, DOC, 2020

Azienda Agricola Valdinerà



Located in the heart of Piedmont near the city of Alba, the Valdinerà estate has been farmed by the Careglio family for four generations. At present, it consists of about 41 acres of which 22 are vineyards. Currently, "Beppe" Careglio grows Arneis, Barbera, Favorita, and, of course, Nebbiolo.

Uncertified Organic Wine Producer states they do not use artificial fertilizers, herbicides or pesticides. While we cannot prove the veracity of this, we also have no reason to believe it is not true.

Tasting Notes

Here's a twist: a wine from Piedmont made from 100% Nebbiolo grapes - but *pink*, not red. Pale pink, delicate bouquet with the taste of dried cherry flavors, and a dry, clean, elegant finish.
