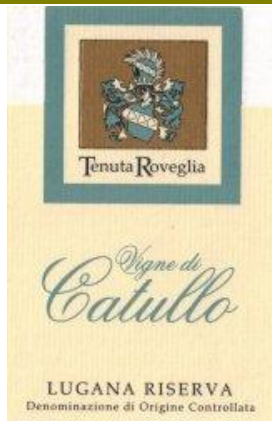

Born in the thirties, Tenuta Rovaglia boasts the most extensive vineyard in the area of Lugana. Tenuta Rovaglia has 125 acres of vineyards within the more than 245 acres of the estate.

Vigne di Catullo is a Lugana of great personality. Its delicate yet robust qualities satisfy the most demanding and discerning palates. The grapes come from the area of Lugana designated as premier cru, which was already heralded for its wine by the ancient Roman poet Catullo two thousand years ago.
