The modern version is pale straw, with varietal aromas, a clean, dry mid-palate and an intriguing finish.



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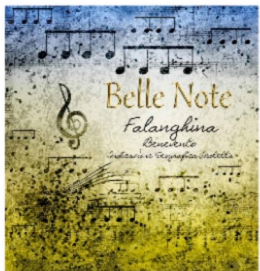
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
